Talent Booker**

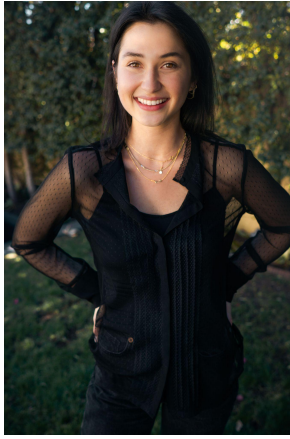
